ADVANCEMENT CAMPAIGN FOR TEACHERS

We are very pleased to announce that we have raised over \$100,000 for the Advancement Campaign for Teachers! After receiving generous gifts of \$10,000 and \$30,000 from local foundations, we have now received **\$113,530.10** for the Advancement Campaign.

Full-time teachers received a **23% salary increase** and part-time teachers and staff received substantial increases as well due to your generous contributions to this campaign. Thank you for loving and supporting our teachers so well!

We believe that we will reach the \$150,000 mark soon, so the school board voted to keep the campaign open until it is fully funded with \$200,000 or until 1 year has passed.
